

MOBILE APPLICATION DEVELOPMENT COMPETITION 2018

The Rules & Regulations

Competition Launch Date: 12 August 2018

Document Update: 24 July 2018



1.0 GENERAL

1.1 Objective

The IEM Mobile Application Development Competition (IEM-MAC) aims mainly for the student members. However, the competition is open to all members categories. The objectives of the competition are to foster creativity among engineering students, to nurture students in project management skills (reporting, time management & presentation skills), and to expose students to the competitive environment in the industry. It is also the aim of the competition to reduce the cost of developing a mobile application for IEM.

1.2 Statement of Agreement

All team members must sign a statement explicitly indicating they have understood and shall abide by the Rules and Regulation of this competition. This statement must be submitted to the Organizing Committee together with the Documentation for the mobile application development.

1.3. Eligibility

The competition is open to all IEM Members

1.4 Team Composition

All groups must be in a group of 3. Student Members - All student team members must be registered students in the current semester from the same IHL during submission of the Documentation together with the Registration Form. Only one team member is allowed to be a non-IEM Member. If any of the team members is not a student member, then this condition will not apply. The mixture of student members with other members categories shall fall under "Other membership categories". Other membership categories — all IEM Members.

1.5 Complaint/Protest

An official complaint preferably with evidence such as a digital photo must be filed by the team leader to the Organizing Committee with a deposit of RM 100 within ONE (1) week of the winner announcement at every competition phase. Should the complaint be rejected by the Organizing Committee, the deposit shall be forfeited. All decisions by the Organizing Committee are final and hence cannot be contested after the winners have been announced during each phase of the competition.

2.0 COMPETITION PHASES

2.1 Phase 1 – Documentation

Submission of mobile application Documentation and registration form.

2.2 Phase 2 - Presentation

Presentation of the documentation from the participating teams. Each presentation will be given 20 minutes. Only 10 teams will be selected to present their ideas/documentation for the mobile application. Only 3 teams will be selected to proceed to the next phase

2.3 Phase 3 - Coding

The three teams selected will be given dummy data to code their mobile application. They will present to the panel of judges. One team will be selected to be the winner and implement the mobile application with actual data.

2.4 Prizes

2.5 Inclusion

The mobile applications must have the look and feel of the IEM website http://www.myiem.org.my/

Basic Requirements

- Information dissemination
- Personalized courses, events, meetings, membership fees payment reminder and other notifications to the user discipline/requirements
- Update on promotions
- Easy links to the social media
- Appearance of Loyalty Card in the logged in area of the application
- Logged in area only applicable to paid members
- A window where members can post their questions to IEM with regards to the route to become a professional engineer

Room for future enhancements:

- Form of ID (i.e. QR code) incorporates the IEM Loyalty Card with merchant's points rebate program
- Online payment of fees or IEM Merchandise
- Online download of Jurutera Bulletin
- Live events broadcasts (talks, IEM dinner, family day)

2.7 Contents

Phase 1 - Documentation must include:

- Flow chart of the process.
- Theory of concept what was used? Adoption of technology.
- Explanation of the feature commands in the mobile apps.

Phase 2 – Presentation of Documentation must include:

- 20 minutes of presentation for each team

Phase 3 – Coding with Dummy Data must include:

- Simple video to show how the program operates
- All codes must be properly commented

2.8 Platform

Only Android and/or iOS platform is acceptable.

3.0 RIGHTS AND PROHIBITION

3.1 Rights

IEM will have the ultimate copyrights to the material submitted and reserved the rights to use or not to use and/or change the codes as deemed necessary.

3.2 Prohibition

All submission must be original and observe the intellectual property rights. It must not contain any prohibited contents. It must not endorse any commercial products and services. Participating team members are NOT allowed to own/use/distribute materials that have been submitted for this competition without written consent by the IEM.
