In 2009, he lead the development of Malaysia's own Green Building Index rating system, which has gained international recognition and garnered government support in the form of Green Cost tax incentives (recently extended to 2020).

Chen has served as President of the Association of Consulting Engineers Malaysia (ACEM); the Institution of Fire Engineers Malaysia (IFEM); ASHRAE Malaysia Chapter; and the Kiwanis Down Syndrome Foundation. He also serves as Advisor to the Malaysian Air-Conditioning & Refrigeration Association (MACRA) since its inception.

In recognition of his contribution to the engineering fraternity, he was honoured with the ACEM Gold Medal Award in 2010.
