<u>SYNOPSIS</u>

Smoke is a major killer in almost all the fire incidents. A good smoke management design is utmost important for the life safety of the occupants during evacuation under the fire scenario. The main objective of the smoke control system should be life safety to ensure safe evacuation of occupants especially in the public building such as shopping complexes, libraries, public train stations and the like. Other objectives of smoke management system include fire fighters life safety, goods protection, and minimizing of business interruptions, etc. Many have since confused on the applications of performance based design and the code compliant design on the smoke control system since the implementation by Bomba more than 5 years ago. A comparison on their differences will be illustrated and discussed in this talk for better understanding.
