<u>SYNOPSIS</u>

This is the third of a series of proposed Law for Engineers talks on principal industrial and employment legislation which will cover the Factories and Machinery Act and Regulations, The Electricity Supply Act and Regulations, The Employment Act and Regulations, The Industrial Relations Act, the Occupational Safety and Health Act and Regulations.

The Occupational Safety and Health Act 1994 (OSHA 1994) and its provisions were explained at a talk on 13th February. OSHA 1994 provides for further nine Regulations. The talk on 4th June was on the following Regulations:

The Occupational Safety and Health (Employers' Safety and Health General Policy Statement) (exception) Regulations 1995.and Safety and Health Committee Regulations 1996.

The talk on 10th. September will touch on Occupational Safety and Health (Safety and Health Officer) Regulations 1997, covering Citation, Interpretation, application, application for registration, qualification for registration, attendance in continuous education programme, Duties of Employers, Duties of Safety and Health officers and

Occupational Safety and Health (Safety and Health officer) order 1997 covering Citation and Commencement, Interpretation, Class or description of Industries required to employ safety and health officers
