He is actively involved with the Institution of Engineer, Malaysia (IEM) as a committee member in the PSESIG 2015/2016 and AFETD 2015/2016. He had presented papers on Determining the Key Predictors Influencing EV Usage Intention in Malaysia at the IEEE Int. Conf. and Utility Exhibition on Green Energy for Sustainable Development in 2014, EV Strategy and Initiatives in Malaysia at the ASEAN-Japan Seminar on Environment Improvement in the Transport Sector in 2012, SIRIM Seminar on Horizon Scanning for Energy Storage Industry in 2012 and APEC Workshop on Energy and Green Transport Benefits of EV in 2011, besides some other locally organized seminars and conferences.
