### PRESENTATION SYNOPSIS

This is the fourth of a series of proposed “Law for Engineers “ talks on principal industrial and employment legislation which will cover the Factories and Machinery Act and Regulations, The Electricity Supply Act and Regulations, The Employment Act and Regulations , The Industrial Relations Act , the Occupational Safety and Health Act and Regulations .

The Occupational Safety and Health Act 1994 (OSHA 1994), The Occupational Safety and Health (Employers’ Safety and Health General Policy Statement)(exception) Regulations 1995, The Safety and Health Committee Regulations 1996. Occupational Safety and Health (Safety and Health Officer) Regulations 1997 and the (Safety and Health officer) order 1997 have been discussed at earlier talks

### **Occupational Safety and Health (Notification of Accident, Dangerous Occurrence, Occupational Poisoning and Occupational Disease) Regulations 2013**

Interpretation of specific terms applicable to the Regulations, Application of the Regulations , Exemption from Part II of the Regulations, Notification and reporting of Dangerous Occurrence, Exemption from requirement of Regulation 5 to self-employed persons, Occupational Poisoning and Occupational Disease, Exemption from requirement of Regulation 7 to self-employed persons, Non-interference at accident or dangerous scene, Maintenance of all Records of accident, Dangerous occurrence , Occupational Poisoning and Occupational disease , Penalty for non-compliance.

First Schedule: Definition of serious bodily injury Second.

Schedule : Dangerous occurrences which are notifiable where they occur.

Third schedule ; occupational poisoning and Occupational Disease

Fourth Schedule: Matters which the Director general May Require to be Notified.
