SYNOPSIS

The recently enacted CIPAA 2012 (Construction Industry Payment Adjudication Act) has attracted a lot of keen interest in the construction industry when it came into operation on 15 April 2014. Since then, close to 600 cases had been registered with KLRCA which is the appointing authority for adjudicators.

The Adjudication process will progress from Payment Claim (Form 1), Payment Response (Form 2) to Delivery of Adjudication Decision (Form 16) over a period of 95 working days.

Who can initiate the Adjudication? How do you commence and prepare for such action? Do you need a lawyer? How to choose an Adjudicator? What happens during the Adjudication Proceeding? Who pays for the Adjudication Costs and what can be done if payment is not met by the losing party after the Adjudication decision? Can the decision be stayed or set aside? What role does KLRCA play? Is there alternative to Adjudication?

The seminar will discuss the above questions.

He is a committee member of the Dispute Avoidance and Resolution Practice of the IEM and the past Chairman (2008-2010) of the Chartered Institute Arbitrators (CI Arb) Malaysia Branch. He is sitting as arbitrator in various on-going arbitrations.
