- 2. Tabling and discussion on Proposed Amendments to the IEM Constitution.
- 3. Voting by Corporate Members present at the SGM with show of hand on the proposed amendments.

The IEM Council wish to inform that further to the approval obtained from members at the 57th Annual General Meeting and subsequently by vote from the general membership, the amendments to Articles 5.1 and 5.2 were submitted to the Registrar of Societies (ROS) for approval. IEM was thereafter informed by the Registrar that the IEM Constitution did not comply with some of the requirements of the Societies Act.

The IEM Council at their 408th meeting held on 24 July 2017 therefore agreed that amendments need to be made to the Constitution to ensure its compliance with the requirements of the ROS. The proposed amendments attached herewith would therefore be presented during the Special General Meeting for approval to be incorporated into the Constitution.

Corporate Members may submit their views (in black and white) to support or object the proposed amendments. 10.8 "Corporate Members" means Fellows, Senior Members and Members of The Institution and includes Distinguished Honorary Fellows, Honorary Fellows and Distinguished Members who have been Members of The Institution.
10.9 "Non-corporate Members" means Distinguished Honorary Fellows, Honorary Fellows and Honorary Members who are not engineers and Graduate Members, Companions, Incorporated Members, Affiliate Members, Associate Members or Student Members.
10.10 "Member" (with capital "M") when used alone means a Corporate Member of the grade of Member.
10.11 "member" (with small "m") when used alone or in the phrases "member of The Institution" or "member of the Branch" shall, unless a contrary interpretation appears, mean a Corporate or a Non-corporate Member.
10.12 "Month" means calendar month.
10.13 "Session" means the period between two (2) consecutive Annual General Meetings
10.14 "Honorary Secretary" or "Secretary" includes any deputy or assistant secretary or any other person appointed by the Council to perform the duties of the Honorary Secretary.
10.15 "Notice" includes a voting paper.
10.16 "Branch" means a regional community of members.
10.17 "Word importing the masculine gender include the feminine gender; and words in the singular shall include the plural, and words in the plural shall include the singular.
