SYNOPSIS

"Who Pays Your Arbitrator and Lawyer's Costs and Fees in Arbitration and How Much?"

In an arbitration setting, costs in arbitration are a concern for parties as the amount is substantial. The disputants are eager to know who bears the costs which include arbitrator and legal costs.

The seminar will explore what are the types of costs and the basis for awarding costs. Would the winner get all his costs or are there exceptions to this general rule of "costs follow event"? How would offer to settle affect costs award?

How can the parties cap costs?

Interest

Debts owed will attract financial interest and this should be of compensatory nature and not punitive.

How could the dispute resolver award interest, should it be simple or compound? Is pre-award interest recoverable and how is it determined?

Must contractual interest rate be honoured to as opposed to statutory rate? Are there exceptions?

The seminar will examine the basis for awarding interest.
