SYNOPSIS

Tan Sri Dato' Seri Prof. Emerita Dr. Sharifah Hapsah was the first female vice chancellor of Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia. Serving in the Faculty of Medicine, she rose to become the founding Professor of Medical Education before she was appointed as Director of the Centre for Strategic and Academic Development in the main campus. At the national level, she served as the chairperson and CEO of the National Accreditation Board (LAN), overseeing the development of the Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA) Act. Internationally, she was the founding secretary of the Association for Medical Education, WHO Western Pacific Region (AMEWPR) and member of the Steering Committee of the

Talloires Network of Community Engaged Universities. She contributed to the development of various Guidelines on Quality in Higher Education. She has received numerous international and national recognitions, including the Fred Katz Memorial Medal and the International Council for Distance Education (COL-ICDE) Award of Excellence. She currently devotes her time to the development and protection of of women, children and families as President of the National Council of Women's Organisations (NCWO) and member of the ASEAN Confederation of Women's Organisations (ACWO).
