SYNOPSIS

Estimates indicate that more than \$500 billion is lost to corruption each year in the global engineering/construction industry. While this economic loss is staggering, it pales in comparison to the losses suffered by people in need of water and wastewater projects, roads, schools, hospitals, and residences to improve their lives. Moreover, corruption kills people when projects are poorly constructed, and it reduces funds for needed infrastructure projects (Henry, 2017).

In the engineering/construction sector, actors range from engineers, constructors, material suppliers, equipment suppliers, regulatory/permitting agencies dealing with procurement and consultants engaged in the preparation and implementation of contracts.

Good governance is recognized as the first line of defense against corruption. Therefore, engineering/construction companies have to devise strategies to address and manage corruption risks effectively and proactively. The comprehensive framework will enable engineering/construction companies to take up challenge of building their corruption resistance to reinforce their own objectives and enhance stakeholder trust in their organizations.

The speaker will explain issues and impacts corrupt practices related in engineering/construction sector. As prevention of corruption, participants were guided strategies in curbing corrupt practices towards achieving certification ISO 37001 (Anti Bribery Management System)
