"How the Data Center Industry is dealing with the COVID-19 Pandemic, and the Current Best Practices for Data Centers

COVID-19 is a pandemic. In situations such as this, mission-critical facilities face particular challenges, due to both the risk of unavailability of key staff through illness or quarantine and other long-term impacts that might affect the ability of the operator to maintain continuous availability. As the virus spreads, more organizations are moving from updating their response plans to implementing them. Each organization is different, and responses vary based on site environment, the number of COVID-19 cases in the area and government-mandated restrictions. This reviews the current status of the data center industry's response to the pandemic and details recommendations and possible next steps.
