## Article 4.4 Economic Activities

The Institution is allowed to engage in economic activities such as sell, purchase, invest, rent, own movable or immovable assets as well as other economic activities such as setting up companies under Companies Act 2016.

## Article 5.1

The Members of the Council shall, subject to Article 5.2, be chosen from amongst Corporate Members of The Institution, and shall comprise :-
(a) The President,
(b) The Deputy President,
(c) The Immediate Past President,
(d) All Past Presidents who are invited by the Council and have expressed their willingness to serve,
(e) The Vice Presidents of whom there shall be not less than two (2) nor more than ten (10), as prescribed in the Bylaws,
(f) The Honorary Secretary,
(g) The Honorary Treasurer,
(h) Ordinary Council Members of whom there shall be not less than twenty (20) nor more than fifty (50), as prescribed in the Bylaws,
(i) One (1) representative from each Branch of The Institution.
(j) Not more than three (3) Corporate Members appointed by the Council on the nomination of the President for a term of one (1) session. An appointed member may be re-appointed, but shall not serve in this capacity for more than two (2) consecutive sessions.
(k) Five (5) Companion or Graduate Members, as prescribed in the Bylaws,
(I) One (1) woman Member as prescribed in the Bylaws.

## ARTICLE X INTERPRETATION

## Article 10.9
