Dialogue of Draft Guidelines On Monitoring Of Airborne Chemical Hazardous To Health



The Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH) is in the process of gathering public comments of the draft Guidelines on Monitoring of Airborne Chemical Hazardous to Health 202X.

The proposed guideline is to supplement the requirement of regulation 26 of the Occupational Safety and Health (Use and Standards of Exposure of Chemicals Hazardous to Health) Regulations 2000.

This proposed guideline is to provide guidance on conducting monitoring of airborne CHTH at the workplace. The guideline describes on the steps of air monitoring, monitoring methodology, sampling technique, monitoring strategy, sample management, sampling results management & interpretation and report writing.

Chemical exposure monitoring is used to measure the level of exposure of workers to chemicals hazardous to health (CHTH) and to evaluate adequacy of existing control equipment.

This IEM member dialogue is to gather engineering input and feedback to DOSH on this draft guidelines.
