Since 2010, Standards Malaysia had been supporting Malaysian young professionals to be involved in International Electrotechnical Comission (IEC) standardisation works by participating in the IEC Young Professionals (IEC YP) programme held in conjunction with the annual IEC General Meeting. Participants are hand-picked by IEC National Committees to represent their country in the Young Professionals Programme.

The IEC YP Programme offers an important networking platform and a unique opportunity to help shape international standardisation and conformity assessment work. The YP workshop offers participants the opportunity to see the IEC in action and meet technical experts from all over the world in order to better understand why participation at the global level is an essential strategic tool.
