## **SYNOPSIS**

Flow Assurance is an important specialized area in the oil and gas industry. A simple definition to the term is 'Assurance to flow', or the science to ensure successful and economical flow of hydrocarbon streams from reservoir to the point of sale. This talk will provide a high-level awareness on Flow Assurance (FA) issues which affect the flow of hydrocarbon stream from the reservoir to the point of sale and the critical operational challenges of one or more of the fluid FA issues during production and transportation of pipelines. It will also cover the mitigation methods for each FA issue.
