

# RESPONSIBILITY OF BORROWERS

#### TERMS OF BORROWING

- Two books may be borrowed at any one time for a period of two weeks
- Only one extension of two week may be granted. Only one reminder will be sent to the borrower at the end of the borrowing period, and the book shall be returned within two weeks from the date of the reminder.
- If the book is not returned within two week, a fine of RM 1.00 per day will be imposed to the borrower
- Standards, Periodicals, Conference Proceedings, RED Spot Collection and IEM Publications are NOT allowed to borrow as these collection are kept under REFERENCE COLLECTION







## RESOURCE CENTRE MAIN SERVICES

#### 4. SIRIM Technical Library

- We provide this service for MEMBERS who are looking for Foreign Standards (BS, IEC, and ISO or other related engineering standard
- MEMBERS can borrow the 15 materials (standards or some guideline from SIRIM Technical Library) within 14 days
- SIRIM card can be collected from IEM Librarian

- Journal and Directories


#### 5. Audio-visual and electronic databases
