

Benevolent Fund

OBJECTIVES AND BENEFICIARIES

To provide relief to IEM members who are incapacitated by or suffering from sickness, accident or other infirmity (whether bodily or mental) and who are unable to pay for their own care. The persons qualified to receive such relief shall be:

- Persons who are active member of the Institution of Engineers,
 Malaysia ("active" by law: members who paid yearly fees constantly) or
- Wives, husbands, widows, widowers, children, father and mother ("dependent")

The Beneficiaries

The beneficiaries shall be classified into two (2) categories:

- Members who are incapacitated by sickness, accident or other infirmity (whether bodily or mental) and who are unable to pay for their own care and/or that of their dependent.
- Dependents of members who are in distressed circumstanced due to the demise of the members.

NOTE

The fund could also be utilized for any other matter which may appear to the Executive Committee of IEM to be incidental or conducive towards carrying out or attaining the objectives of the IEM Benevolent Fund.



Application

• Application should be made by members of the dependent who shall be the beneficiary of the fund.

Quantum of Awards

- Lost of Capabilities Accident and Sickness Lump sum of RM3,000.00.
- Death Lump sum of RM5,000.00.

Note:

However, should there be special cases, the Welfare Committee can request for special consideration.

Other Contribution and Requests

- To be approved a the discretion of the Standing Committee on Welfare and Member Services and the Executive Committee.
- The application to be submitted to IEM Secretariat within a year from the incident date.

JURUTERA WARGAMAS SCHEME

CONDITIONS OF APPLICATION

IEM Corporate Member who has met the following conditions is qualified to apply for 'Jurutera Wargamas Scheme' and to pay only 25% of Annual Subscription.

1

CATEGORY A

A Corporate Member between the age of 55 to 65 and has retired from regular employment and is not permanently employed by any company and is unemployed and has paid the Annual Subscription for twenty (20) years or more.

2

CATEGORY B

A Corporate Member who has not reached 55 and has paid the Annual Subscription for fifteen (15) years or more and is not permanently employed by any company and is unemployed because of health reason or permanently disability only.

JURUTERA WARGAMAS SCHEME

3

CATEGORY C

A Corporate Member who has been retrenched before 55 and is not gainfully employed should have paid the Annual Subscription for twenty (20) years. This concession becomes invalid as soon as the Corporate Member is employed again.

The applicant should make a statutory declaration regarding the employment status for Category B & C.

MEMBERS ABOVE THE AGE OF 70

Members above the age of 70 and who have been paying subscriptions for the last ten (10) years <u>shall be exempted</u> from paying Annual Subscription.

Note: Automatic under Membership Section

BYLAW (Article 4.7 under Payment of Annual Subscription)

Any Corporate Member who has reached the age of sixty-five (65) years on 1st of January of the year and who has paid his Annual Subscription for a period of not less than twenty-five (25) years preceding shall be exempted from payment of further subscription, provided that he is no longer in gainful employment.

For students seeking internships, Student Member may login with IEM Student Member details to search or browse available internship opportunities.


