# **SYNOPSIS**

The Occupational Safety and Health (Amendment) Act 2022 (Act A1648), which was passed and gazetted in 2022, will come into force on 1 June 2024. The new OSHA Act A1648 is formulated to integrate the Occupational Safety and Health Act 1994 ("OSHA") and Factories and Machinery Act 1967 ("FMA") (repealed) to provide a comprehensive safety and health legislation that applies across all industries. This workshop aim to provide an insight into the salient points of the new OSHA Act and explain what the duty holders need to do and how they are involved in management of risk of a construction project. Managing occupational safety and health risks at the planning and design stage is often more effective, easier to sustain, and cheaper to do than making changes later when the hazards become real risks in the workplace. The course will also provide some insight on the compliance, enforcement and challenge of the OSHA (Amendment).

## SPEAKER'S PROFILE




Ir. Ts. Wong Chee Fui
