- A command-and-control centre for centralized testing and vehicle data telemetry;
- A digital twin simulation lab enabling virtual validation and AI-driven scenario testing.

This visit presents a unique opportunity for IEM members to directly explore and engage with one of Malaysia's most advanced mobility testbeds. The AVXL platform is not only critical to Malaysia's national AV-as-a-Service (AVaaS) development framework, but also supports broader efforts in smart mobility, urban innovation, and automated systems validation.
