I.O INTRODUCTION/PURPOSE

Mediation and Expert Determination are some of the contemporary Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) methods used internationally and to a growing extent locally to resolve disputes including those in the Engineering and Construction Industry. In fact, some Engineering and Construction contracts contain express provisions making mediation as a mandatory pre-condition to arbitration. Lately, Expert Determination clauses are also being featured in contemporary Forms of Contract.

Mediation has been put on a firmer footing with the enactment of the Mediation Act 2012 (Act 949) and the implementation of the Chief Justice's Practice Direction 2/2022. It is also used extensively by the courts in Court-Annexed Mediations as well as on an "ad hoc" basis for pre-action mediations.

Expert Determination on the other hand was introduced to this country by PAM for its latest suite of Building contracts. Recently, the Borneo International Centre of Arbitration and Mediation (BICAM) launched the BICAM Expert Determination Rules on 15th April 2025 and commenced with the empanelment of Experts for a wide-ranging spectrum of disputes including engineering and construction disputes.

In view of the above developments, it is imperative for every practitioner, especially the engineers, to be familiar with the workings of Mediation and Expert Determinations. Hence, this one-day course has been specially formulated with the above in mind and to serve as a comprehensive introduction to the nature and workings of these newly emerging methods of ADR.
