



## ENGINEERS SHARPEN KNOWLEDGE ON PROFESSIONAL INDEMNITY COVERAGE

A virtual half-day course titled **“The Nuts and Bolts of the Professional Indemnity Insurance Procured by Various Project Professionals”**, organised by the Public Sector Engineers Special Interest Group of The Institution of Engineers, Malaysia (IEM), attracted nearly 30 participants on 11 February 2026.

The session was moderated by Ir. Bhupinder Singh, Chairman of PSESIG. Held via Zoom, the event featured Ir. Pooba Mahalingam, who shared valuable insights into professional indemnity insurance for project professionals. The speaker, who is also a professional engineer, presented engaging case studies illustrating how PI policies are structured and triggered.

The course was approved by the Board of Engineers Malaysia (BEM) for three Continuing Professional Development (CPD) points. Participants praised the engaging presentation and the relevance of the content, which covered key aspects of professional indemnity insurance procurement. One participant described the session as “informative and well structured”. The event concluded with a productive Q&A session addressing participants’ queries.

The course highlighted the importance of understanding professional indemnity insurance in project management, particularly for engineers and project professionals. IEM plans to organise similar events in the future, focusing on professional development and knowledge sharing.

The event was well received, with participants appreciating the opportunity to enhance their knowledge while earning CPD points. A course on C.A.R. policy coverage with the same speaker is also planned in the near future.
