Report on Technical Visit to New LCCT Earthworks Package at KL International Airport on 31 July 2010

Thirty five (35) members from IEM visited the on-going earthworks package for the new Low Cost Carrier Terminal (LCCT) complex at Kuala Lumpur International Airport in Sepang on 31 July 2010. The project managers for the project, KLIA Consultancy Sdn Bhd were at hand to provide a technical briefing together with the consultants for earthwork packages 1 and 2. A representative each from HSS Integrated Sdn Bhd and Straits Consulting Engineers Sdn. Bhd. also provided updates on the scope of work and the current work progress at site. As highlighted by the project consultants, the ongoing ground improvement works for both packages included prefabricated vertical drains with surcharge, with surcharge duration varying between 4 months to 6 months. Following the technical briefing arrangements were made for a tour of the project site, with the group subdivided into several smaller sub-groups. Following the site visit, an interesting question and answer session was conducted.
