**~ SYNOPSIS ~**

The purpose of the visit is to have a better understanding on Howard Alaptanian Sdn Bhd (HASB). HOWARD Malaysia was established in 1962 as a trading company by a retired planter, who wanted to introduce rotavation to Southeast Asian farmers. In 1976 it was converted to a manufacturing company, in joint venture ownership between the HOWARD Group and Malaysian National Farmers Association (NAFAS). During this period, HOWARD played its role in assisting local farmers convert from manual to mechanical soil cultivation. Malaysian paddy farmers have today practically fully mechanized their field work, and are in this respect considered pioneers in Southeast Asia.
