SYNOPSIS

The direct combustion of EFB biomass as boiler fuel to produce steam to drive the turbine is a typical method of utilization of EFB biomass in power generation. Other potential EFB biomass power generation technologies are reviewed. The BOOT scheme can play a big role in promoting the construction of EFB biomass power generation plants. To encourage EFB biomass renewable energy projects, the government is reviewing and revising Feed-in-Tariffs for connection to the grid and offering better terms and conditions under REPPA (Renewable Energy Power Producer Agreement)

Ir. Ooi Ho Seng graduated from the University of Malaya with a Bachelor of Engineering degree (Mechanical) in 1972 and a Master in Engineering Science degree in 1975.
