Lumpur. Professor George Lee is currently a clinical Associate Professor of Surgery at Monash University, Sunway Campus and Consultant Urological Surgeon from Gleneagles Intan Medical Centre, Kuala Lumpur.

Professor George Lee has keen interests and publishes extensively in his field of endourology, prostate diseases and men's health. He is well known for his regular appearances with BFM radio station, RTM morning program and respectable magazines.
