SYNOPSIS

The competitiveness of electricity tariff is a common topic in the power generation market as it is vital to the development of a country's economy and it affects the livelihood of the public. Hence it is always one of the key criteria to be evaluated when awarding a tender to build a power plant. The electricity tariff comprises of multiple components in which the single largest component is made up of fuel cost.

This talk draws attention to the fuel diversification in a power market (e.g. Malaysia) and the different fuels which determine the fuel specific electricity tariff. The talk aims to shed lights on how a regulated market's electricity tariff is being computed with respect to the different type of power plant technologies from oil-fired power plant to combined-cycle power plant to coal-fired power plant. Each power plant technology has its advantages in supporting the electricity grid and also its drawbacks. This will be elaborated in the talk.
