**Ir. Zaki Anhar** is a Mechanical and Energy Engineer caught in a love affair with fuels. Although his career has brought him in close contact with various fuels, coal has always had a special place in his heart.

After graduating from Cardiff University with a MEng (hons) in Mechanical Engineering and MPhil in Mechanical Engineering and Energy Studies, he

spent his early career in Kapar Energy Ventures (KEV), which still stands as the largest multi-fueled power plant in Malaysia. After leaving KEV, he joined Shell Global Solutions, International, dealing with Downstream And LNG Utilities. He is now the Executive Director of IFME Consultants, which is the Main Independent Coal Specialist for TNB Fuels, whereby he is tasked with conducting Trial Burns for all new coals sent to Peninsular Malaysia Coal Fired Power Plants.

Ir Zaki has also conducted Coal Quality and Utilisation Training in Malaysia for the open market, and also for TNB.
