
Today, we have more than 41,000 IEM members

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

LESSONS from the GEESE





Lessons from the GEESE ...

As each Goose flaps it's wings, it create UPLIFT for the birds that follow. By flying in V-formation the whole flock adds 71% extra flying range.

LESSON:

People who work as a TEAM often produces better quantity and quality OUTCOME ... because they are thinking and piggy-back ideas of one another.



Lessons from the GEESE ...

When a Goose falls out of formation it suddenly feels the drag and resistance of flying alone. It quickly moves back to take ADVANTAGE of the lifting POWER of the birds in front.

LESSON:

We should stay in formation with those headed where we want to GO; where we are willing to accept their help and give our help to others.

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Lessons from the GEESE ...

When the lead Goose tires, it drops back into formation and another Goose flies to the POINT Position.

LESSON:

It pays to take turn doing the hard tasks.

We should RESPECT and PROTECT each other's unique arrangement of skills, capabilities, talent and resources.



Lessons from the GEESE ...

The Geese flying in formation HONK to encourage those up front to keep with the speed.

LESSON:

We need to make sure our HONKING is encouraging. In group where there are encouragement, PRODUCTION is much greater. Individual empowerment results from QUALITY honking.



Lessons from the GEESE ...

When a Goose gets sick, two Geese drop out of formation and follow it down to HELP and PROTECT it; forming a V-formation when the sick Goose is well and ready to fly again.



LESSON:

We need to standby each other in difficult times as well as when we are strong.
