SYNOPSIS

Recent escalator accidents have led to heightened concerns and scrutiny of the escalators in operation questioning if they are not up to acceptable safety standards. Most of the escalators installed in Malaysia generally are designed to EN115 standards and there are some designed to JIS and other globally acceptable standards. Malaysia has an established standard MS 1918-1:2011 for escalators which is based on EN115. The installation and maintenance of escalators is governed by Jabatan Keselamatan dan Kesihatan Pekerjaan (JKKP).

This talk will centre on discussion of the safety requirements in these standards and cause of these accidents. Were they caused by poor design? The use of substandard materials? Or due to poor installation and maintenance quality?
