## **SYNOPSIS**

Nominated Sub-Contracts are a category of sub-contracts and are therefore generally subject to the same standard rules as are applicable to domestic sub-contracts. However, the mechanism of "nominating" sub-contracts is one which has evolved to cater to special requirements of the construction industry (especially building construction) so that:

- > the main building works can be awarded first without details of finishes and services being finalized; and
- project clients can have a greater degree of control over the selection of the parties who are to carry out the relevant works and also their details

Accordingly, nominated sub-contracts carry distinctive features in that project clients have a closer relationship with nominated sub-contractors without privity between them. This talk shall therefore deal with the general features of sub-contracts and then deal with distinctive features of nominated sub-contracts under the commonly used by PAM 2006 Form of Contract.

## **BIODATA OF SPEAKER**

**Ir. Lim Eng Chong** is a construction contracts specialist with BSc, LLB, MIEM, PEng, CLP, Advocate & Solicitor (not in practice). Ir.
