SYNOPSIS

Without good people management skills, even the most carefully planned project can fall apart in a flash. Managing people effectively means more than just keeping them in line: It means using finely tuned interpersonal skills and astutely reading emotional cues to get the job done right and on time.

Survey indicated that most Project Managers (PMs) didn't know very much about emotional intelligence (EQ). Project Managers understand basic project management tools and techniques and those are prerequisites for success even as a junior PM but to advance your career, you will need strong interpersonal skills or soft skills and emotional intelligence provides the framework for those skills. PMs who master emotional intelligence will set themselves apart from other PMs. They will be able to achieve more with the same team. They will excel in their careers and they will feel more satisfied with themselves and their relationships with others.
